

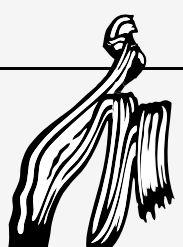

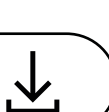
The Museo Reina Sofía is a public institution devoted to exploring modernity and to bringing contemporary art closer to society, doing so via exhibitions, public programmes, educational activities and research projects understood as spaces of thought and transformation.

Visitors to the Museo can discover works and documents which encompass artistic diversity and art’s potential to be a driving force for social change. Therefore, we encourage you to explore both the Museo Reina Sofía Collection and the temporary exhibitions.

Please bear in mind that at the present time the Museo is immersed in the rearrangement of its Collections, a process which will run until 2028, which means that some of its rooms are temporarily closed and certain works are being relocated.

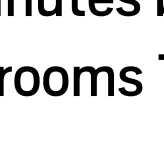

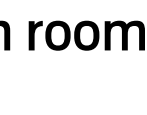
OTHER GALLERIES

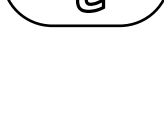

MEDIATION AND ACTIVITIES

Every day, the Mediation programme offers guided tours, in different formats, which span the Museum’s Collection and the temporary exhibitions, in addition to other proposals which converse with an expanded idea of cultural mediation. 

Furthermore, the Museum offers a programme of public activities which foster dialogue around exhibitions, the Collection and topical issues. 

ACCESSIBILITY

In its commitment to universal accessibility, the Museum works to constantly improve its services and develop its education programme based on the principle of universal design.

The Museum has at its disposal folding cane seats and wheelchairs, ramps, adapted WCs and parking reserved for disability-adapted vehicles. There are also magnetic loops, induction loops, sign-language guides, audio-guides with audio-descriptions and guided tours tailored for people with visual impairments, hearing loss and intellectual disabilities. 

ACCESS

Visitors can access the Museum with small bags for personal belongings and small backpacks (a maximum size of 40 x 30 x 10 cm), which must be worn at the front of the body at all times.

Access with suitcases, large backpacks and large objects is not permitted, and items cannot be left in the available lockers if their length exceeds 50 cm.

Access with guide dogs and the corresponding accredited assistance is guaranteed.

Accessing the Museum with animals is not permitted.



VISITS

Rest areas can be found in the Museum’s Cloister, the Sabatini Building Garden and in the Nouvel Building’s Rooftop Terraces.

Visitors can request wheelchairs and folding cane seats from the Information Desks.
